

Establishment of Warsaw Branch Office of Mitsubishi Corporation LT Europe GmbH

Mitsubishi Corporation LT Europe GmbH, which is headquartered in Dusseldorf, established a branch office in Warsaw, Poland in January 2007, and operations there began on April 1.

Using a warehouse space in the suburb of Broni (a logistics center approximately 30 km from Warsaw), the office is mainly responsible for the storage and delivery within Poland of chemicals, chemical resins, consumer products, and materials and machinery for use as factory equipment.

Eastern Europe is drawing increasing attention as a production area and consumer market, and many Japanese manufacturers and sales companies have located there. By carrying out logistics business there, mainly warehousing, and providing high-level services, we will raise the level of the comprehensive services that we provide.

Geographically, Poland is situated between the mature market of Western Europe, the developing market of Russia, and Turkey, which is aiming to join the EU. We believe that taking advantage of this “advantage of place” by getting live information from those places, will be of crucial importance for the future development of MCLOGI’s business and functions.

Poland has a favorable geographical situation, as it is located next to Russia and is a member of the EU, making it possible to transport goods to Russia overland (by road or train) without passing through the Baltic nations. In cooperation with MC Logistics CIS, which was established in Russia approximately one year ago, we will begin transporting goods bound for Russia.
